
The undersigned, ROBERT W. DARNELL, President and Chairman of the Board of Directors, of THE GREATER SARASOTA SERTOMA FOUNDATION, INC. certifies that:

- 1. I am the President and Chairman of the Board of Directors of THE GREATER SARASOTA SERTOMA FOUNDATION, INC., a Florida Notfor-Profit Corporation, which Articles of Incorporation were filed with the Secretary of State, State of Florida, on July 24, 1996.
- 2. The following amendment to the Articles of Incorporation was unanimously adopted by the Board of Directors, at a special meeting at which all of the Directors were present and voting throughout, duly called for the purpose of adopting this Amendment and held on February 17, 1997, and member approval was not required.
- 3. The Articles of Incorporation are hereby amended to read as follows:

"ARTICLE VI

Limitation of Corporate Powers

The corporate powers of this corporation are as provided in Section 617.0302, Florida Statutes. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization



exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

ARTICLE IX

Dissolution of Corporation

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes."
