ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF BAY AFRICAN-AMERICAN RESPONSE TO AIDS.INC

The undersigned subscribers to these Articles of Incorporation, each a natural person competent to contract. Hereby associate them for the purpose of forming a corporation not for profit under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE 1

<u>NAME</u>: The name of the corporation shall be "BAY AFRICAN-AMERICAN RESPONSE TO AIDS INC", hereinafter referring to as "BAAR".

ARTICLE II

<u>PURPOSE</u>: This organization will be known as Bay African-American Response to Aids [BAAR] an association of concerned citizens interested in educating the community about HIV transmission and prevention and providing HIV testing and counseling, herein after referred to as the "Coalition".

ARTICLE III

<u>POWERS</u>: The powers of BAAR shall include, but not limited to the collection and disbursement of charitable contributions, the management and operation of the generally accepted practices necessary to conduct business as a non-profit organization.

ARTICLE IV

EXISTENCE: BAAR is to exist perpetually pursuant to the laws and statutes of the State of Florida, commencing June 15, 1995.

ARTICLE V

ARTICLE VII

<u>AMENDMENTS:</u> These Articles of Incorporation may be amended from time to time in the manner provided by applicable law. Every amendment shall be approved by the Board of Directors as provided for in the by-laws of BAAR.

AMENDMENTS

- Said organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or the private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof. No substantial part of the activities of organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office, Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, this organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the internal revenue code, corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning if section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located. Exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
