Articles of Incorporation
InterCultural Library Center, Incorporated
A Florida Nonprofit Corporation

The group of Volusia County citizens, whose names appear below as Founding Directors, has convened on this date for the purpose of forming a corporation. The group agrees as follows:

Article I - Name of the Corporation

The name of the Corporation shall be The InterCultural Library Center, Incorporated, hereinafter also referred to as "the Corporation."

Article II - Definition

The Corporation is a not-for-profit, non-sectarian, egalitarian, quasi-voluntary corporation organized under Chapter 617, Florida Statutes. It is not organized for the private gain of any person.

Article III - Duration

The duration of the Corporation shall be perpetuity.

Article IV - Purpose

The purpose of the Corporation is to establish a central institution that will provide a collection of books, magazines, films, videos, and other publications relating to diverse cultures and their contributions in the making of America and the world. An important part of the library's program will consist of the lending of these materials to local citizens. It is an objective of the Corporation to generate interest in the participation of cultural activities, and to provide a forum for individual persons to learn how to live in peace with themselves and with others who may be superficially different. This forum will also serve to bring together parents and children thereby strengthening familial ties and establishing more elevated social and family values.

The Corporation will avail itself of mass media, readings, lectures, story telling, the viewing of films, and music appreciation to promote fellowship, understanding and a feeling of regard, more than merely marginal tolerance, for others. The facility will serve citizens of all ages, but especially youth, as a forum for the exchange of ideas and for the study of the factors that have served to divide and separate people of diverse cultures. The Founding Directors feel that the course of history suggests an eventual and ineluctable unification of the human race. The sooner acceptance of other human beings becomes a part of collective consciousness, the sooner will the hydra of cultural, social, economic inequities disappear and racial, ethnic and religious intolerance come to an end.

The Directors feel that their views reflect the growing awareness of increasing numbers throughout the United States that a unified rather than fragmented citizenry will have vast, far-reaching psychological, economic and social benefits for the country, and, indeed, for the entire world. The pursuit of this idea forms the foundational cornerstone for the InterCultural Library Center, Incorporated.

Article V - Administration

The Administration of the Corporation shall be undertaken by a Board of Directors. The initial Directors who convened to organize the Corporation are herein designated "Founding Directors." The tenure of Founding Directors shall be for life. Subsequent directors shall be elected by a majority of Corporation members in the manner set forth in the Corporate By-Laws. The number of Directors shall in no case be less than three. A Corporation member is herein defined as an individual over 18 years of age who has demonstrated concern for the realization of the Corporation's purpose, as such purpose is stated in Article III above, and by attending not less than five general meetings within a calendar year period, and by having participated in the work of any standing committee as evidenced by his or her attendance at 50% or more of the meetings or activities of such committee.

Amendments to these Articles of Incorporation and to the Bylaws of the Corporation shall be made only by a majority vote of the Directors. A tie vote shall be decided by the Chairperson, who, in that event, will cast an additional vote. It shall not be within the purview of any member of the Corporation who is not also a Director to effect any change in the Articles or the Bylaws.

Article VI - Officers

The officers of the Corporation shall consist of a Chairperson, Vice Chairperson, Secretary, and Treasurer. Other officers may be provided for in the Bylaws. Each officer shall be elected by the Board of Directors (and may be removed by the Board of Directors) at such time and in such manner as may be prescribed by the Bylaws. 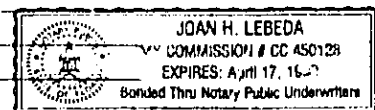
