ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF DESTIN RESTAURANT ASSOCIATION, INC.

Α

Corporation Not for Profit

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of the corporation is: DESTIN RESTAURANT ASSOCIATION, INC.

ARTICLE II. DURATION

This corporation possesses perpetual existence.

ARTICLE III. PURPOSES AND POWERS

This corporation shall act on behalf of the best interest of all persons or entities engaged in the restaurant business in the City of Destin and South Walton County, Florida. It's primary purpose is to provide a clearing house for information relative to all issues and matters involving or affecting entities engaged in the restaurant business and their employees. The corporation will educate the public and governments through publications as well as public discussion groups, forums, panels, advertising, lectures and other programs.

The corporation shall have the power to exercise any other powers permitted by the Florida Corporate Law.

ARTICLE IV. QUALIFICATIONS FOR MEMBERS

The corporation shall regulate the qualifications for membership through its By-Laws.

ARTICLE V. REGISTERED AGENTS

The street address of the initial registered office and name of the registered agent of this corporation are: James W. Grimsley, 25 Walter Martin Road, NE, Fort Walton Beach, Florida 32548. The principal address shall be the same as above.

ARTICLE VII. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

This corporation shall have 3 directors initially. The names, street addresses and mailing addresses of the initial directors of the corporation are: Richard W. Hicks, 110 B Palmetto, Destin, FL 32541, P O Box 99, Destin, FL 32540; Robert A. Bonezzi, 110 B Palmetto, Destin, FL 32541, P O Box 99, Destin, FL 32540 Chuck Highers, 110 B Palmetto, Destin, FL 32541, P O Box 99, Destin, FL 32540

The method of the election or appointment of Directors is stated in the By-Laws of the Corporation.

ARTICLE VIII. CERTIFICATES OF MEMBERSHIP

The corporation is organized on a non-stock basis. Membership in the corporation shall be evidenced by a certificate of membership.

ARTICLE IX. AMENDMENT

The corporation reserves the right to amend or repeal any provisions contained in these Articles of Incorporation, or any amendment to them, and any right conferred upon the members is subject to this reservation.

ARTICLE X. EARNINGS.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributab' to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof.

ARTICLE XI. DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Circuit Court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
