Amendment to Article I (Name Change)

Old Name (The Inner-City Brighter Life Foundation Inc.)  
New Name (Brighter Life Inc.)

Amendment to Article III (To be Added)

- A. To provide Residential habilitation to developmentally disabled in a group home setting with the residential habilitation being specific training activities that help the individual to acquire, maintain or improve daily living skills, which includes the following services.
- (a) Focus on personal hygiene skills: Such as bathing and oral hygiene.
  - (b) Develop homemaking skills such as food preparation, vacuuming , and laundry.
  - (c) Enhance social and adaptive skills that enable the individual to reside in the community.
- B. To provide supported living coaching to developmentally disabled., where the supporting living coach provides training and assistance in a variety of activities to support the individual who lives in their own homes or apartments. The coach provides assistance in the following areas:
- (a) The acquisition, retention, or improvement of skills related to activities of daily living such as personal hygiene and grooming, house hold chores, meal preparation, shopping, personal finances and the social and adaptive skills necessary to enable individuals to reside in their own homes or apartments.
