Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, the undersigned Florida nonprofit corporation adopts the following articles of amendment to its articles of incorporation

FIRST: Amendments Adopted:

Amended: Articles III

ARTICLE III - Purpose

The specific purpose(s) for which the corporation is organized is (are):

1. Not for profit, charitable fund raising, for community development and educational enrichment and to assist the underprivileged socially, financially or as otherwise necessary to promote and create a better way of life and living.

2. The general purposes for which this corporation is formed are to operate exclusively for religious, charitable, and educational purposes which will qualify it as an exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code 1986 or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws, including, for those purposes, the making of distributions to organizations which qualify as tax-exempt organizations under that Code.

3. This corporation shall not, as a substantial part of its activities, carry on propaganda or otherwise attempt to influence legislation; nor shall it participate or intervene (by publication or distribution of any statements or otherwise) in political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

And by adding the following Articles to the Articles of Incorporation for Allen Human Services Development Corporation, Inc.

Added: Article IX and Article X

ARTICLE IX - Amendments

This corporation reserves the right to amend, alter, change, repeal, any provisions contained in this amended articles of incorporation in like manner as set forth herein for

amendments and changes to the By-Laws, as herein after prescribed by law, and/or the most current edition of The Doctrine and Discipline of the African Methodist Episcopal Church.

ARTICLE X - Dissolution of Corporation

Upon the dissolution of this corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, (or corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), or shall be distributed to a state or local government, for public purposes. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by Court of competent jurisdiction in the county in which the principal office of the organization is located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

SECOND: The date of the Adoption of the amendment was November 13, 1998.
