ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
SCULPTURAL ARTS CENTER, INC.

The undersigned Incorporator, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the name Sculptural Arts Center, Inc., hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the Corporation shall be: SCULPTURAL ARTS CENTER, INC.

ARTICLE II - NOT FOR PROFIT

The Corporation is a nonprofit corporation under the laws of the State of Florida. The Corporation is not formed for pecuniary profit. No part of the income or assets of the corporation is distributable to or for the benefit of its Members, Trustees, or Officers, except to the extent permissible under law.

ARTICLE III - PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal place of business and mailing address of this Corporation shall be:

ARTICLE IV - PURPOSES

The Corporation is organized for the following purposes:

To receive and administer funds and to operate exclusively for charitable, scientific and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or comparable provisions of subsequent legislation. These purposes include but are not limited to sponsoring, organizing, administering, enhancing, and operating activities that benefit the public, including, but not limited to the operation of a cultural arts center which would teach appreciation and offer hands-on courses in the arts, especially in the fields of sculpture, painting, pottery, ceramics and jewelry enameling.

To exercise all rights and powers conferred by the laws of the State of Florida upon nonprofit corporation, including without limiting the generality of the foregoing, to acquire by bequest, devise, gift, purchase, lease or otherwise any property of any sort or nature without limitation to its amount or value, and to hold, invest, reinvest, manage, use, apply, employ, sell, expend, disburse, lease, mortgage, convey, option, donate, or otherwise

dispose of such property and the income, principal and proceeds of such property, for any of the purposes set forth herein.

To do such other things as are incidental to the purposes of the Corporation or necessary or desirable in order to accomplish them.

ARTICLE V - SHARES

The Corporation will not have or issue shares of stock. No member of the Corporation has any vested right, interest or privilege in or to the assets, property, functions or activities of the Corporation.

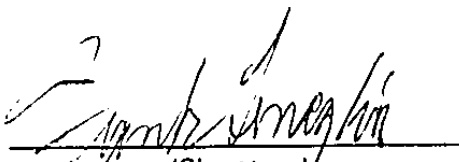

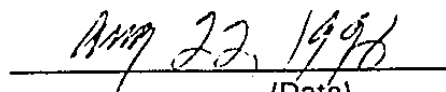
