ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, acting as Incorporator of a corporation pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopted the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

Name

The name of the corporation shall be: Orlando Aikikai, Inc.

ARTICLE II

Principal place of business and mailing address

The initial principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be:

1854 Destiny Blvd., #308
Kissimmee, FL 34741

ARTICLE IV

Purpose(s)

The purposes for which Orlando Aikikai, Inc. is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, scientific, literary, and educational within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 and the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue law. The specific purpose(s) for which the corporation is organized is (are):

1. To perpetuate the art of Aikido.
2. To establish and maintain a training hall and educational facility.
3. To conduct training and educational programs and courses.
4. To write, create, publish, produce, disseminate, and distribute, training and educational materials and products regarding the art of Aikido.

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TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

5. To establish and maintain a museum, and cultural exhibits and/or center(s).
6. To establish and maintain a membership organization for Aikido students and teachers.
7. To conduct such other lawful activities and enterprises as will support these purposes.

ARTICLE IV

The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed is as follows:

There shall be five (5) directors, each serving one five year term. The initial director shall be the incorporator, for whom 1995 shall be the first year of his term. The second director shall be elected at the February 1996 membership meeting. One director shall be elected at each succeeding annual meeting until all five directors are elected. Each year thereafter, an election will be held at the annual membership meeting to replace the director whose term is expiring. Vacancies shall be filled by a special election called and held for such purpose.

ARTICLE V

Limitation of corporate powers

The corporate powers of this corporation are as provided in section 617.0302, Florida Statutes. Notwithstanding any provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 and the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

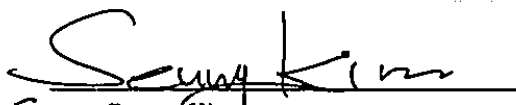

Dissolution

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government or to the state or local government for public purpose. Any assets not so disposed of, shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county of which the principle place of business has been located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organizations as said court shall determine, which shall also be organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
