**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

A Corporation Not For Profit

THE UNDERSIGNED, acting as incorporators of a Corporation Not For Profit pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

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TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

**ARTICLE I - NAME**

The name of this corporation shall be:

**THE SOBRO ARTS PROJECT, INC.**

**ARTICLES II - PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS AND MAILING ADDRESS**

The principal place of business and the mailing address of this corporation shall be:

**ARTICLE III - PURPOSES**

The specific purposes for which this corporation is organized are:

- \* To provide an opportunity and an environment for a wide variety of performing artists to strengthen and enhance their individual and collaborative talents and skills.
- \* To provide performing artists the opportunity to study with world renown guest artists through special masterclasses and workshops, and to provide professional and creative challenges for future growth.
- \* To further encourage artistic excellence through the availability of studio space to performing artists, and to provide the opportunities to perform before a live audience.

This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

#### **ARTICLE IV - MANNER OF ELECTION OF DIRECTORS:**

The manner of which the directors are elected or appointed is as provided by the Corporate By-Laws.

The incorporators shall be the initial directors.

#### **ARTICLE V - LIMITATION OF CORPORATE POWERS**

The corporate powers of this corporation are as provided in 617.0302, Florida Statutes, unless limited as follows:

A. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or, be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of its charitable purposes as set forth in Article III hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under 170 (C) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

B. Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Circuit Court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations as the said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
