ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

TWIN CITIES OPTIMIST CLUB, INC.

In compliance with the requirements of Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, the undersigned have this day voluntarily associated themselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation not for profit, and do hereby certify:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is:

TWIN CITIES OPTIMIST CLUB, INC.

ARTICLE II

The principal office of the corporation is located at: 1820 Huntington Road, Niceville, Florida 32578.

ARTICLE III Resident Agent

Kimberlea A. Wonsick, located at 1820 Huntington Road, Niceville, Okaloosa County, Florida 32578, is hereby appointed the initial resident agent of this corporation.

ARTICLE IV Purpose

The purpose of this organization shall be to develop Optimism as a philosophy of life; to promote an active interest in good government and civil affairs; to inspire respect for the law; to promote patriotism and work for international accord and friendship among all people; to aid and encourage the development of youth, in the belief that the giving of one's self in service to others will advance the well-being of man, his community and world.

This organization is not organized for profit, but will be operated exclusively for the promotion of social welfare and the net earnings will be devoted exclusively to charitable, educational, or recreational purposes.

ARTICLE V Membership

Any person who is invited to the TWIN CITIES OPTIMIST CLUB, INC. may apply for membership in this organization with full privileges thereof, and may become a member by favorable action by the Board of Directors and upon the collection of all dues and fees prescribed by the laws of the Club.

A membership card and certificate shall be issued to each member, or such other evidence of membership as the Board of Officers may select.

Whereas Federal Statutes have been enacted establishing a national policy of nondiscrimination, be it resolved that it is the declared policy of the corporation that

that there be no discrimination based on race, creed, color, sex, religion or national origin in the administration of this organization.

ARTICLE VI Voting Rights

Voting shall be by individuals and shall be conducted by ballot. No person shall cast more than one (1) ballot. Proxies and absentee ballots will not be recognized. The votes shall be immediately tabulated by the advisory committee and the results presented to the membership. A plurality of the votes cast shall elect (i.e. the candidate receiving the largest number of votes shall be declared elected). In case of a tie, the two candidates receiving the largest number of votes shall be voted upon against, in runoff fashion, until the tie is broken.

ARTICLE VII

The officers of the corporation shall be a President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer, as follows:

PRESIDENT: Thomas Muldowney - see article XV

VICE-PRESIDENT: Linda Flowers - 1142 Rhonda Dr., Niceville, 32578

SECOND VICE-PRESIDENT: Timothy Ferguson - see article XV

SECRETARY: Kimberlea A. Wonsick - see article XV

TREASURER: Kimberlea A. Wonsick - " " " "

The government of this organization shall be vested in elected officers and an advisory committee appointed by the same.

The officers of this organization shall be elected in the manner prescribed in the By-Laws and shall held office for a period of one (1) year, or until their successors are duly elected and charged.

ARTICLE VIII By-Laws and Constitution

There shall be one form of Constitution and By-Laws for the TWIN CITIES OPTIMIST CLUB, INC., which shall be the only laws by which each member shall be governed and a copy shall be furnished to each member.

It is the obligation and responsibility of each member to comply with the Constitution and By-Laws of this organization, and the orders of its proper officers when in conformity therewith; and shall refrain from conduct that tends to or is designed to interfere with the performance or duties or obligations of the members. Not only shall the Constitution and By-Laws be binding on the officers of the corporation, but likewise shall apply to any other organization who by their own acts have made themselves associates before and after the fact.

No officer or member of this organization may resort to any court of law or equity or other civil authorities either as parties or plaintiffs for the purpose of securing an opinion or decision in connection with any alleged grievance or wrong concerning any case in controversy arising within this organization or under its laws until such officer or member shall have exhausted all remedies as provided herein, not inconsistent with applicable law, for the settlement and disposition of such alleged rights, grievances or wrongs.

ARTICLE IX Term of Existence

This corporation shall exist perpetually.

ARTICLE X Dissolution

In the event of dissolution, the residual assets of the organization will be turned over to one or more organizations described in Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or corresponding sections of any prior or future Internal Revenue Code, or of the State, Federal or Local government for exclusive public purpose.

ARTICLE XI Activities

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by (a) a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue code of 1954, or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law, or (b) a corporation contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or any other corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

ARTICLE XII Corporate Powers

This corporation shall have all of the corporate powers provided by Florida Statutes 617.021.

ARTICLE XIII

Any amandment to these Article of Incorporation, if in conformity with the Constitution and by-laws of Optimist International, may be adopted by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the members present at any meeting, provided written notice of the proposed amendment and date of such meeting shall have been given the members at least two (2) weeks prior thereto.
