# ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, acting as incorporators of a corporation pursuant to chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

#### ARTICLE 1

#### Name

The name of the corporation shall be Full Gospel Missions Fellowship Church, Inc.

#### **ARTICLE II**

# Principal place of business and mailing address

The principal place of business of this corporation shall be:

# **ARTICLE III**

#### Purpose(s)

This is a non-profit corporation organized solely for Christian and charitable purposes pursuant to the Florida Corporations Not for Profit law set forth in Part I of Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes. The object and purpose for which this corporation is formed (none of which shall be for pecuniary profit) are as follows:

#### Section 1:

- A. To operate exclusively for religious purposes.
- B. In furtherance of and within the scope of paragraph A:



- To propagate to the general public the doctrine of our Lord Jesus Christ and
   His Gospel, including the doctrine of salvation by the shedding of His blood.
- (2). To help in the fulfillment of the Great Commission to carry the Gospel to all creatures.
- (3). To accomplish the above by means of the establishment of independent local sovereign fellowships, home and foreign missionary activities, to establish, maintain, and conduct schools for religious education and instruction. This shall be accomplished by means of, but not limited to, television, films, radio, Bible studies, seminars, literature, personal appearances, study retreats, recordings, records, video cassettes, and publications of musical materials.
- C. In furtherance of and within the scope of the purposes stated in Paragraph A, the corporation is empowered:
  - (1). To rent, lease, exchange, buy, and in any and all other ways acquire, take, hold and own, and deal in, rent, lease, sell, or otherwise dispose of all and every kind of property, real and personal, or mixed, without limitations as to amount or value.
  - (2). To do such other things as the corporation's Board of Directors may consider proper or necessary to carry the foregoing purposes into effect.

Section 2: In the furtherance of the purposes heretofore set forth, this corporation shall have the power and authority established in Section 617.021, Florida Statues. The exercise of such powers shall not be to influence legislation to affect the outcome of any political campaign or otherwise deviate from its primary purpose which is intended to qualify it as an exempt organization under

Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding provisions of any subsequent tax laws.

Section 3: Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles of Incorporation, this corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by (a) a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law, or (b) a corporation, contributions which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code or any other corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

#### **ARTICLE IV**

#### Manner of election of directors

The manner in which directors are elected or appointed is as follows:

The officers of the corporation shall be a pastor-president, a secretary, a treasurer, one or more vice-presidents and such other officers as may be elected. The officers of the Church shall be elected annually by a majority vote of the active church membership at the annual business meeting. The term of membership shall be for a one (1) year period, except for the Pastor-President, who shall be a continuing member of the Board of Directors. On the first Wednesday of November, the Board of Directors will present its slate of officers to the church. At this time the general membership may present any nominations that they might have. Election will take place at the annual church meeting in December. Installation of officers will be held on the first Sunday in January. Any member of the Board of Directors must also be a member of the congregation of the Church. If an officer cannot complete his term, the Board of Directors will appoint a replacement for the duration of the term.

# ARTICLE V

# Limitation of corporate powers

The corporate powers of this corporation are as provided in section 617.0302, Florida Statutes.

private individual.

Section 4: Distribution of Assets. Upon the dissolution or winding up of this corporation, its assets

shall be distributed to OC International, a non-profit organization organized and operated exclusively

for Christian religious and charitable purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under

Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
