OF

Pursuant to Section 617.0202, Florida Statutes

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is:

The Martin F. Bock Family Foundation, Inc.

ARTICLE II

The address of the principal address of the corporation is:

ARTICLE III

The purpose of the corporation is as follows:

To exclusively receive, administer and donate funds for scientific, educational and charitable purposes, and to that end to hold any property, or any undivided interest therein, without limitation as to amount or value: to dispose of any such property and to invest, reinvest, or deal with the principal or the income in such manner as, in the judgment of the directors, will best promote the purposes of the corporation without limitation, except such limitations, if any, as may be contained in he instrument under which such property is received, these Articles of Incorporation, the Bylaws of the corporation, or any applicable laws; to do any other act or thing incidental to or connected with the foregoing purposes or in advancement thereof, but not for the pecuniary profit or financial gain of its directors or officers.

To have, in furtherance of its not-for-profit corporate purposes, all of the powers conferred upon corporations organized under the Florida not-for-profit Corporation Act, subject to any limitations thereof contained in these Articles of Incorporation or under the laws of the State of Florida.

The general purposes for which this corporation is formed are to operate exclusively for such scientific, educational and charitable purposes as will qualify it as an exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws, including, for such purposes, the making or distributions to organizations which qualify as tax-exempt organizations under that Code.

ARTICLE IV

The provision for qualification of members and the manner of their admission will be provided for in the by-laws.

ARTICLE V

The initial board of directors shall consist of four (4) members. The names and addresses of the directors are as follows:

ARTICLE VI

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, the corporation is organized exclusively for one or more of the

purposes as specified in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, and shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under IRC Section 501(c)(3) or corresponding provisions of any subsequent Federal tax laws.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of any member, trustee, director, officer of the corporation, or any private individual (except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the corporation), and no member, trustee, officer of the corporation or any private individual shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the corporate assets on dissolution of the corporation.

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation (except as otherwise provided by Internal Revenue Code section 501(h)), or participating in, or intervening in (including the publication or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of any candidates for public office.

In the event of dissolution, all of the remaining assets and property of the corporation shall after necessary expenses

thereof be distributed to another organization exempt under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent Federal tax laws, or to the Federal government, or state or local government for public purposes, subject to an order of a Justice of the Supreme Court.

In any taxable year in which the corporation is a private foundation as described in section 509(a) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, the corporation shall distribute its income for suid period at such time and mannor as not to subject it to tax under section 4942 of the Code and the corporation shall not (a) engage in any act of self-dealing as defined in section 4941(d) of the Code (b) retain any excess business holdings as defined in section 4943(c) of the Code (c) make any investments in such manner as to subject the corporation to tax under section 4944 of the Code or (d) make any taxable expenditures as defined in section 4945(d) of the Code or corresponding provisions of any subsequent Federal tax laws.
