ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION AMERICAN MUSEUM OF ENTREPRENEURS, INC.

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BY THESE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION the subscribers form a corporation under Florida law

1. NAME. The name of this corporation is American Museum of Entrepreneurs, Inch.

- 2 INITIAL PRINCIPAL OFFICE. The address of the initial principal office and the registered office address of the Corporation is 2881 E. Oakland Park Blvd., Suite 200, Ft. Lauderdale, Florida 33306
- 3. PURPOSE. The purpose for which this corporation is organized is the formation and operation of an educational museum.
