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#### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

#### NORTH FLORIDA CONSERVATORY FOR THE PERFORMING ARTS, INC.

We, the undersigned subscribers to these Articles of Incorporation, natural persons, competent to contract, have associated ourselves and do hereby form a corporation, not-for-profit, under the laws of the State of Florida.

# NAME NAME The name of the corporation shall be the North Florida Conservatory, for the Performing Arts, Inc. ARTICLE II

#### **PLACE OF BUSINESS**

The principal place of operations for this corporation shall be Tallahassee, Leon County, Florida. Its address is: 1355 East Tennessee Street, Tallahassee, Leon County, Florida 32308, or such other location that the Board of Directors may from time to time designate.

#### ARTICLE III

#### **PURPOSES**

The specific purposes for which the corporation is organized shall be:

- 1. To provide training and awareness to children relative to the performing arts including but not limited to stringed instruments; dance; music theory, terminology and history; literature, and academics.
- 2. To conduct a conservatory which includes: tutorial programs, a homework center, and after school educational conservatory, and a school of the performing arts for people of all ages.
- To provide other comprehensive services deemed essential in children and youth development, including but not limited to building self-esteem, self-discipline, etc.

- 4. To educate the public about the contribution of minorities in the performing arts.
- 5. To disseminate general information, network and exchange knowledge thereof.
- 6. To encourage, plan, promote and coordinate programs, seminars and workshops relative to the performing arts and music business education for children, youths and parents, particularly minorities, and the community at large.
- 7. To contract, conduct, promote, participate and provide services related to public relations, mass communications, and associated fields including, but not limited to radio, television, newspapers, magazines, journals, signs, posters, handbills, etc., in carrying out the purposes set forth.
- 8. To carry on any or all of its operations and to promote its objectives within the State of Florida or elsewhere, without restrictions as to place or amount, and to have, use, exercise and enjoy all of the general powers of like corporations.

#### ARTICLE IV

#### TERM OF EXISTENCE

This corporation shall have perpetual existence.

#### ARTICLE V

#### **EMPLOYEES**

The Board of Directors shall have the authority to appoint or employ an executive director and/or other staff members as required to manage the daily affairs of the corporation.

#### **ARTICLE VI**

#### **BOARD OF DIRECTORS**

The method for election or appointment of directors shall be as stated in the bylaws of this corporation. The government and policy-making responsibilities for North Florida Conservatory for the Performing Arts, Inc., shall be vested in the Board of Directors which shall control its property, be responsible for its finances, and direct its offices.

#### ARTICLE VII

#### BYLAWS

Bylaws for this corporation may be amended or altered by 2/3 vote of the Board of Directors at any regular or special meeting, provided that the notice for the meeting includes the proposed amendments. Any proposed amendments shall be submitted in writing at least ten (10) days prior to the meeting at which they are to be considered.

#### **ARTICLE VIII**

#### **AMENDING ARTICLES**

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended by 2/3 vote of the Board of Directors in good standing and in attendance at a regular meeting provided such amendments shall be plainly stated in the notice for the meeting at which they are to be considered.

#### ARTICLE IX

#### **EXEMPTIONS AND LIMITATION OF POWERS**

The private property of the Board of Directors of this corporation shall not be liable for the debts of this corporation, but shall be wholly exempt therefrom. Further, the corporate powers of this corporation shall be as provided in Section 617.0302, Florida Statutes.

#### ARTICLE X

#### CONFLICTS

In the event of conflicts between language found in the Articles of Incorporation and the Bylaws, the Articles of Incorporation shall be controlling.

#### ARTICLE XI

#### DISSOLUTION

The corporation may acquire, take by gift, grant, purchase, devise, or bequeath, real and personal property, including grant awards, for purposes appropriate in the exercise of its powers, and may lease, mortgage and dispose of real and personal property including the right to take, hold, and dispose of shares of stock in other corporations.
