## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF



## First Christian Church By Faith of Miami, Inc.

The undesigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida General Corporation Act, does hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation

Article 1. Name.

The name of the Corporation is First Christian Church By Faith of Miami, Inc.

Article 2. Duration.

The duration of the Corporation is perpetual

Article 3. Purposes.

A This corporation is a not-for-profit corporation organized under Chapter 617, Florida Statutes. It is not organized for the private gain of any person. The specific purposes of this corporation are

One: To foster an appreciation and understanding of The Word of God.

To Praise the Lord.

- B To exercise all rights and powers conferred by the laws of the State of Florida upon nonprofit corporations.
- C. Provided, however, that the corporation shall not engage in any action which is is not permitted to be carried on by nonprofit corporations under the Internal Revenue Code and no part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, directors, or officers; but the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation to these people for services rendered, and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of its stated purposes.
