## ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

NARANJA PRINCETON COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION

Pursuant to the provisions of Sections 617.1001 and 617.1002, Florida Statutes, the undersigned corporation submits the following articles of amendment:

1. The name of the corporation is: The Naranja Princeton Community Development Corporation.

2. The following amendment to the articles of incorporation was adopted by the board of directors on September 16,1997.

3. There are no members entitled to vote on the proposed amendment.

4. The articles of incorporation for Naranja Princeton Community Development Corporation are amended to add Article Nine which reads as follows:

## ARTICLE NINE

Upon dissolution of this corporation/organization assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal government or to a state or local government. for a public purpose.
