APTICLES OF INCORPORATION

FILIPINO-AMERICAN ASSOCIATION OF SOUTHWEST FLORIDA

Pursuant to section 617, 1007, Florida statutes, the Article of Incorporation of the Filipino -American Association of Southwest Florida, Inc. not for profit, non-political and non secturian are as follows:

ARTICLE 1

NAME: The name of the corporation, herein called the "Association," is Filipino-American A sociation of Southwest Florida, Inc., and its address is 4595 Palm Beach, Blvd., Fort Myers, Florida, 33905.

ARTICLE 11

PURPOSE AND POWERS: The purpose for which the Association is organized is to unify all Filipinos residing in Southwest Florida into a civic- oriented group to promote the general welfare of its members and the community in which they reside; to develop, improve, and perpetuate excellent Filipino-American relationship; to help unemployed, displace, and destitute Filipino residents in the area; to engage in wholesome, productive and lawful activities; and to act as an ambassador of goodwill for the Philippines.

(A) To make and collect assessments against members of the Association in order to defray the costs, expenses and losses of operating the Association and to use the proceeds of such assessments in the exercise of its powers and duties.

(B)) To engage in lawful fund-raising programs to supplement the funds indicated in preceding provisions (A) when the need arises.

(C) To receive donations, grants, gifts or any funds in any form as additional supplements to the above.

(D) To protect, repair and operate the Association property.

(E) To make, Amend and enforces reasonable rules and regulations.

(G) To enforce the conditions and restrictions provided by these Articles, the Constitution and By Laws and any rules and regulations of the Association.

(II) To employ professionals personnel to perform the services required for its proper operation. (I) All funds and titles to all properties acquired by the Association shall be held for the benefit of the members in accordance with these Articles and its Consitutiona and by laws.

(J) To establish and administer the following programs:

1. Educational Programs

- a. Scholarship Program To provide financial assistance to the poor but deserving dependents of the members.
- b. Outstanding achievement Award program for the Youth To give an award to students between the ages of 13 and 21 with an outstanding achievements in academics, sport, arts, languages and others.

c. Filipino-American Youth Leadership Conference.- To prepare our youths to become an effective leaders and good citizens.

II. Cultural Program: To encourage members to participate in cultural programs that would reflect our cultural heritage in the best possible light.

III. Charitable Program: To participate in or initiate fund-raising campaigns for creditable and bonafide charitable organizations.

ARTICLE 111

MEMBERSHIP:

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(A) The membership in the Association consists of three (3) classes: Regulars: Associates and Honorary. Membership to the Association is open to all Filipinos or Filipino-Americans and non-Filipinos of good moral character residing in the Southwestern part of the state of Florida. Filipino Americans referred to former Filipino citizens who have acquired American citizenship through naturalization or by birth.

1. Regular members:

- (a) Filipinos and Filipino-Americans
- (b) Non-Filipino citizens who are related to any Filipino or Filipino-American by mariage, adoption or birth.

2. Associate Members:

- (a) Non-Filipinos who have rendered valuable services to the Philippines or to any of its citizen and is willing to support the Constitution and By Laws of the Association.
- (b) Any applicant falling under this category must be sponsored by a regular member.

3. Honorary Members:

Honoray membership may be conferred to any non-Filipino or non Filipino American provided that such individual have rendered valuable and meritorious services to the Philippines or to any group of Filipinos or to any Filipino- American Community. The applicant must be sponsored by a regular member of the Association.

- (B) The share of a member in the funds and assets of the Association cannot be assigned or transferred in any manner except authorized by law.
- (C) The manner of exercising voting rights is set forth in the By Laws.
- (D) After termination of the Association, the members shall consist of hose who are members of the Association at the time of such termination.

ARTICLE 1V

TERM: The term of the Association shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE V

CONSTITUTION BY BY LAWS: The Constitution By Laws of the Association may be altered, amended or rescinded in the manner provided herein.

ARTICLE VI

DIRECTORS AND OFFICERS:

- (A) The affairs of the Association shall be administered by a Board of Directors, consisting of the number of Directors determined by the By Laws but not less than (7) directors.
- (B) Directors of the Association shall be elected by the members in the manner determined by the By Laws. Directors may be removed and vacancies on the Board of Directors shall be filled in the manner provided by the By Laws.
- (C) The businesses of the Association shall be conducted by the officers designated in the By Laws. The officers shall be elected by the Board of Directors and shall serve at the pleasure of the Board.

ARTICLE VII

- AMENDMENTS: Amendments to these Articles shall be proposed and adopted in the following manner:
 - (A) Proposal: Amendments may be proposed by a majority of the Board or by petition of twenty -five per-cent (25%) of the members.
- (B) When an amendment or amendments to these Articles are proposed by said Board or members, such proposed amendment or amendments shall be submitted to a vote of the members not later than the next annual meeting for which proper notice can be given.
- (C) Vote Required: Except as otherwise required by Florida law, these Articles of Incorporation may be amended by a vote of not less than fifty-one (51%) of the entire voting interests present in person or by proxy at any annual or special (general) meeting, provided that notice of any proposed amendment has been given to the members of the Association, and that the notice contains a fair statement of the proposed amendment.
- (D) Effective Date: An amendment shall become effective upon filling with the Secretary of State and recording a certified copy in the Public Record of Lee County, Florida.

ARTICLE VIII

Indemnification: To the fullest extent permitted by Florida law the Association shall indemnify and hold harmless every Director and every officer of the Association against all expenses and liabilities, including professional fees, actually and reasonably incurred by or imposed on him in connection with any legal proceeding (or settlement or appeal of such proceeding) to which he may be a party because of his being or having been a Director or an officer of the Association.

The forgoing right of indemnification shall not be available if a judgment of the final adjudication establishes that his actions or omissions to act were material to the crause adjucicated and involved;

- (A) Willful misconduct or a conscious disregard for the interests of the Association, in a proceeding by or in the right of the Association to procure a judgment in its favor.
- (B) A violation of criminal laws, unless the Director or officer has no reasonable cause to believe his was lawful.
- (C) A transaction from which the Director or officer derived improper personal benefit.
- (D) Wrongful conduct by Directors or officers in a proceeding brought by or on behalf of the Association.
- (E) In the event of a settlement, the right to indemnification shall not apply unless the Board of Directors approves such settlement as being in the interest of the association. The foregoing rights of indemnification shall be in addition to and not exclusive of all other rights to which a Director or an officer may be entitled.
