The undersigned, acting as the incorpor for the purpose of forming a Not-For-Profit Corporation, pursuant to Florida Statutes Chapter 617, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this Corporation is: Little Havana Community Team, Inc.

ARTICLE II- PRINCIPAL CORPORATE ADDRESS

The principal corporate address of this Corporation is: 400 N.W. 2nd Avenue, Room 412, Miami, Florida 33130.

ARTICLE III NATURE OF BUSINESS

The general purposes for which this Not-For-Profit Corporation is organized are as follows:

- A. To conduct educational and charitable programs by providing the mostly minority residents and public community with information, resources and advocacy centers aimed at helping poor families and children, including but not limited to teaching the English language, providing job skills training and promoting community service. Increase awareness and availability of recreational, educational and cultural activities. Provide a forum used to discuss and debate issues of community concerns and strenghen the relationship between minorities and police.
- B. To receive and administer funds and to operate exclusively for educational, scientific, literary, charitable or religious purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the

Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or comparable provisions of subsequent legislation (hereafter "Code").

- C. To acquire, own, purchase, lease, dispose of and deal with real and personal property and interests, either absolutely or in trust therein and to apply gifts, grants, bequests, and devises and the proceeds thereof in furtherance of the purposes of the corporation.
- D. To do such things and to perform such acts to accomplish its purposes as the Board of Trustees may determine to be appropriate and are not forbidden by Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, with all the power conferred on Not-For-Profit Corporations in the State of Florida.

LKTICLE IV SHARES

The Corporation shall not issue shares of stock.

ARTICLE V TERM OF EXISTENCE

The Corporation shall exist perpetually unless dissolved according to law.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal Income tax under Section 501 (c) (3) of the I.R.C., or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 (c) (2) of the I.R.C., or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Code or Law.


