ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

MOTHERS' VOICES OF SOUTH FLORIDA, INC.

a Florida Not for Profit Corporation

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of Mothers' Voices of South Florida, under the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of the Corporation is:

MOTHERS' VOICES OF SOUTH FLORIDA, INC.

and the principal place of business is:

555 N.E. 34 St., No. 1503 Miami, Florida 33137

ARTICLE II. COMMENCEMENT OF EXISTENCE

The existence of the Corporation will commence on the date of filing of these Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE III. PURPOSE

This Corporation is formed for the purpose as will qualify it as an exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code") including for such purposes, the making of distributions for organizations which qualify as tax-exempt organizations.

Within the scope of the foregoing, the object of this Corporation and its purposes are solely benevolent. Its primary purpose is serve as a coordination, information, and educational resource for mothers, family members, loved ones, and all persons affected by HIV/AIDS disease. It will link affected individuals with the appropriate means for research, support, and care while offering a venue of empowerment through education, volunteerism, community development, and political advocacy.

ARTICLE IV. ACTIVITIES NOT PERMITTED

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this Corporation will not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code.

ARTICLE V. DEDICATION AND DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of any member, director or officer of the Corporation or any private individual (except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the Corporation affecting one or more of its purposes) and no member, director or officer of the Corporation or any private individual shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the corporate assets upon dissolution of the Corporation.

Upon the dissolution of the Corporation or the winding up of its affairs, the assets of the Corporation shall be distributed to Mothers' Voices, Inc., a not-for-profit corporation organized under the laws of the State of New York, or if this organization has dissolved or is no longer qualified as a 501° not-for-profit

organization, to one or more charitable, religious, scientific or educational organizations which would then qualify under the provisions of Section 501° of the Code and its regulations.

ARTICLE VI. INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The street address of the initial registered office of the Corporation is 555 N.E. 34 St., No. 1503, Miami, FL 33137 and the name of the Corporation's initial registered agent at that address is Barbara Gaynor.

ARTICLE VII. INITIAL BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Corporation shall have five (5) directors initially elected or appointed in accordance with the bylaws. The number of directors may be increased from time to time, as provided in the bylaws, but shall never be less than five.

The Corporation shall have two (2) classes of voting members:

CLASS A: Class A members shall be directors and shall be entitled to vote.

CLASS B: Class B members shall not be entitled to vote.

ARTICLE_VIII._INDEMNIFICATION

Every person who now is, hereafter shall be a Director or Officer of the Corporation shall be indemnified by the Corporation against all costs and expenses (including attorney fees) hereafter reasonably incurred by or imposed upon him in connection with, or resulting from, any action, suit or proceedings of whatever nature, to which he is or shall be made a party by reason of his being or having been a Director or Officer of the Corporation (whether or not he is a Director or Officer of the Corporation at the time he is made a party to such action, suit or proceeding, or

at the time such cost or expense is incurred by or imposed upon him) except in relation to matters as to which he shall be finally adjudged in such action, suit or proceeding to have been derelict in the performance of his duties as such Director or Officer. The right of indemnification herein provided shall not be exclusive of other rights to which any such person may not or hereafter be entitled as a matter of law.

ARTICLE IX. MEMBERSHIP

The membership of this Corporation shall consist of all persons hereinafter named as Directors and all other persons as, from time to time hereafter, may be elected to membership by the Board of Directors. The Directors shall from time to time prescribe the form and manner in which application may be made for membership, and members may be admitted by the Board of Directors only. The authorized number of the members of the Corporation, the different classes of membership, the property voting and other rights and privileges of members, and their liability for dues and assessments and the method of collection thereof shall be set forth in the Bylaws.

ARTICLE X. INCORPORATOR

ARTICLE XI. BYLAWS

The power to adopt, alter, amend, or repeal bylaws shall be vested in the board of directors. Upon notice properly given, the Bylaws may be amended, altered or

repealed by a majority vote of the Directors present at any regular or special meeting called for the purpose, subject to any limitations set forth under the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act.

ARTICLE XII. AMENDMENTS

The Corporation reserves the right to amend, alter, change, or repeal any provision in these Articles of Incorporation in the manner prescribed by law, and all rights conferred on members are subject to this reservation. The amendment may be proposed by any member of the Corporation. Every amendment shall be unanimously approved by an affirmative vote of the Board of Directors.

ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF SECRETARY OF STATE MOTHERS' VOICES OF SOUTH FLORIDA, INC. TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

Article V of The Articles of Incorporation of Mothers' Voices of South Florida, Inc., a Florida Not-For-Profit Corporation, hereinafter referred to as the "Corporation," is amended to read as follows:

ARTICLE V. DEDICATION AND DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of any member, director or officer of the Corporation or any private individual (except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the Corporation affecting one or more of its purposes) and no member, director or officer of the Corporation or any private individual shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the corporate assets upon dissolution of the Curporation.

Upon the dissolution of the organization, all property and assets shall be distributed to Mothers' Volces, Inc., a New York not-for-profit corporation, if in existence and if exempt under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. If the named recipient is not in existence or not exempt under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, all property and assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3), or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located,
