**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
NAPLES JUNIOR CHAMBER, INC.**

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is Naples Junior Chamber, Inc., and the street address of the initial principal office of the corporation is 2950 64th Street SW, Naples, Florida 34105.

**ARTICLE II
PURPOSE**

The purpose for which the corporation is organized and the objects of the corporation are:

- a. To promote, foster, encourage and develop leadership training, through community development, for persons between the ages of 18 and 40 years of age, both inclusive, to service to the City of Naples, County of Collier, State of Florida, and the United States of America.
- b. To carry on any and all activities necessary to promote the general welfare of said city, county and state in the United States of America.
- c. To stimulate and assist with the personal development of the members of the corporation.
- d. The corporation shall be empowered to publish papers, pamphlets, newsletters, bulletins, books, and magazines; to acquire, rent, lease, let, own, hold, buy, convey, mortgage, borrow, sell, or assign property, both real and personal, as the purpose of this corporation, either expressed or implied, shall require; to associate itself with other persons, corporate or natural, for the purposes of becoming a member of associations of similar or like nature, or and otherwise associating itself with other corporations or organizations, or entities with similar purposes, specifically including the state, national, and international Jaycee organizations, and to support these organizations and entities financially in order to promote the common goals and causes, to be able to raise revenues to the advantage of the corporations, to employ staff, contract for services, receive funds from governmental agencies and private sources, and in general, to perform all such other acts and things as from time to time would be necessary to effect any or all of the aforesaid purposes to the extent permitted by law.

ARTICLE III DIRECTORS

ARTICLE V MEMBERS

The qualifications of members and the manner of their admission shall be as follows:

- a. Any person between the ages of 18 and 40, both inclusive, desiring to obtain the leadership training to serve the City of Naples, County of Collier, State of Florida, in the United States of America, shall be eligible to become an active member of the Corporation. Any person 41 years of age or older who is interested in leadership training through the community service shall be eligible to be an associate member but shall not have the right to vote or hold office.
- b. The manner of admission of any member shall be upon written application therefore to this Corporation, acted upon favorably by such number of qualified members of this Corporation, or its Board of Directors as may be prescribed by the By-Laws hereof.

ARTICLE VI BY-LAWS

The By-Laws of the Corporation are to be made, altered, or rescinded by the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the members of the Corporation present and voting at a meeting called for that purpose after 10 days notice.

**ARTICLE VII
AMENDMENTS TO ARTICLES**

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended by the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the members of the Corporation present and voting at a meeting called for that purpose after 10 days notice. Amendments may be proposed in writing by any three (3) members in good standing of that Corporation.

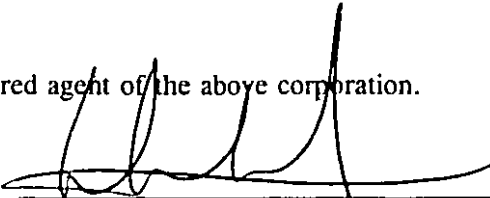
