

RESTATED AND AMENDED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

CITA FOUNDATION, INC. A Florida Not-For-Profit Corporation



The undersigned persons, the Board of Directors of Cita Foundation, Inc., a Florida Not-For-Profit Corporation, whose original Articles of Incorporation were filed on December 3, 1996 and assigned document number N96000006117, adopt the following Restated and Amended Articles of Incorporation for such corporation. The Board of Directors are authorized under Article XI of the Articles of Incorporation to amend the Articles of Incorporation. The Articles of Incorporation were amended on June 16, 1997 by an unanimous vote of the Board of Directors, to add Articles XIV, XV, and XVI.

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation is Cita Foundation, Inc.

ARTICLE II

The address of the principal office of the corporation and its mailing address is: One Penn Plaza, Suite 4307, New York, New York 10119-4300.

ARTICLE III DURATION

This corporation shall have perpetual duration.

ARTICLE IV PURPOSES

The general purpose of this corporation shall be research, education, and treatment of indigents with respect to addition to opiates and recovery from addiction to opiates.

ARTICLE V POWERS

This corporation shall have the power to do everything necessary, proper, or convenient for the accomplishment of any of the purposes herein set forth, and to do every other act incidental thereto which is not forbidden by the laws of the State of Florida or by the provisions of these Articles of Incorporation, including, but not limited to, power to perform contracts for

any lawful purpose, to engage in various funding and fund raising activities, and to acquire, hold, operate, maintain, and lease real and personal property to effectuate its purposes.

ARTICLE VI MEMBERS

This corporation is organized upon a non-stock basis.

The qualification for members and the manner of their admission shall be as regulated by the By-Laws.

The members of this corporation shall have no right, title, or interest whatsoever in its income, property, or assets, nor shall any portion of such income, property, or assets be distributed to any member on the dissolution or winding-up of this corporation. The members of this corporation shall have no voting rights. Members of this corporation shall not be personally liable for the debts, liabilities, or obligations of the corporation, and shall not be subject to any assessments.

ARTICLE VII REGISTERED AGENT AND OFFICE

The street address of the initial registered office of the corporation is Stanford R. Solomon, Solomon & Benedict, P.A., 3000 NationsBank Plaza, 400 North Ashley Drive, Tampa, Florida 33602. The name of its initial Registered Agent at such address is Stanford R. Solomon.

ARTICLE VIII DIRECTORS

The powers of this corporation shall be exercised, its property controlled, and its affairs conducted by its Board of Directors. The number of Directors shall initially be three (3). However, such number may be changed as provided by the By-Laws.

ARTICLE X DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution or winding up of this corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of the corporation, shall be distributed to a not-for-profit fund, foundation, or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 as amended, (all other Section references refer to this source unless otherwise stated) or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws.

ARTICLE XI AMENDMENT

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended by a majority vote of the directors.

ARTICLE XII PRIVATE FOUNDATION RULES

The corporation, during the period it is a "private foundation" as defined in Section 509(a), may not: (a) engage in any act of "self-dealing", as defined in Section 4941(d), which would give rise to any liability for the tax imposed by Section 4941(a); (b) retain any "excess business holdings" as defined in Section 4943(c), which would give rise to any liability for the tax imposed by Section 4943(a); (c) make any investment which would jeopardize the carrying out of any of its exempt purposes, within the meaning of Section 4944, so as to give rise to any liability for the tax imposed by Section 4944(a); and (d) make any "taxable

expenditures" as defined in Section 4945(d), which would give rise to any liability for the tax imposed by Section 4945(a).

During the period the corporation is a "private foundation" as defined in Section 509 of the Code, it shall distribute for the purposes defined in these Articles of Incorporation, for each taxable year, amounts at least sufficient to avoid liability for the tax imposed by Section 4942(a).

ARTICLE XIII DIVIDENDS PROHIBITED

This corporation may not pay dividends to its members, directors, or officers, although this corporation may pay compensation in a reasonable amount to its members, directors, or officers for services rendered and may confer benefits upon its members in conformity of its purposes and as permitted by Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes.

Article XIV Purposes of Corporation

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, the corporation is organized exclusively for one or more of the purposes as specified in Section 501(c)(3) and shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) or corresponding provisions of any subsequent law.

Article XV Earnings

No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of any member, trustee, director, officer of the corporation, or any private individual (except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the organization), and no member, trustee, or officer of the organization or any private individual shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the organization's assets on dissolution of the organization.

Article XVI Prohibited Activities

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation (except as otherwise provided by Section 501(h) or participating in, or intervening in (including the publication or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.
