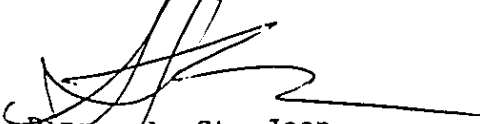

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE ONE

The name of the corporation is GLADES HAITIAN AMERICAN ORGANIZATION FOR ACTION, INC.. The principle address of the corporation is: 118 S.W. 3rd Street, Belle Glade, FL 33430.

ARTICLE TWO

The mailing address of this corporation shall be: 118 S.W. 3rd Street, Belle Glade, FL 33430.

ARTICLE THREE

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is that of a civic organization established and maintained. not for profit, but to improve the quality of life for Haitian Americans in the Glades area, to wit :

1. To unite all Haitian Americans in the Glades area.
2. To educate Haitian Americans in the American political process and to encourage them to participate in Federal, State, and Local elections.
3. To promote voter registration of Haitian Americans in the Glades area.
4. To protect Civil and Human rights of all Haitian Americans in the Glades area.
5. To promote educational and economic development in the Glades area for the benefit of all Haitian Americans.

ARTICLE FOUR

The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed is described in the by-laws of the corporation.

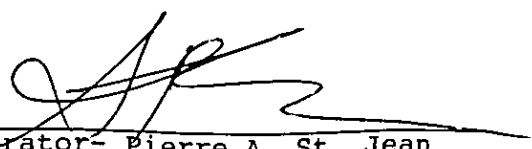
