

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF GLENEAGLES ADOPT A SCHOOL, INC.

96 CEC -9 PH 5: 14

TALLE COLLEGE FLORIDA

The undersigned by these Articles associate themselves for the purpose of forming a corporation not for profit and certify as follows:

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation shall be GLENEAGLES ADOPT A SCHOOL, INC., and is referred to in this instrument as the Corporation. The principal address of this corporation is C/O Gleneagles Country Club, 7667 Victory Lane. Delray Beach, FL 33446.

ARTICLE II - PURPOSE

- A. The Corporation is organized to promote education and community support for schools. It is formed exclusively for charitable, educational and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501 of the Internal Revenue Code (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).
- B. No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth above. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a Corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501 of the Internal Revenue Code (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

ARTICLE III - MEMBERS

The qualifications for members and the manner of their admission shall be regulated by the Corporation's By-Laws.

ARTICLE IV - DIRECTORS

The method of election of Directors shall be as provided in the Corporation's By-Laws.

ARTICLE V - BY-LAWS

The first By-Laws of the Corporation shall be adopted by the Board of Directors and may be altered, amended or rescinded in the manner provided by the By-Laws.

ARTICLE VI - NON-STOCK ENTITY

The Corporation is organized on a non-stock basis.

ARTICLE VII - INDEMNIFICATION

Every Director and every officer of the Corporation shall be indemnified by the Corporation against all expenses and liabilities, inc. ling counsel fees (at all trial and appellate levels) reasonably incurred by or imposed upon him or them in connection with any claim, proceeding, litigation or settlement in which he may become involved by reason of his being or having been a Director or officer of the Corporation. The foregoing provisions for indemnification shall apply whether or not he is a Director or officer at the time such expenses and/or liabilities are incurred. The foregoing rights to indemnification shall be in addition to and not exclusive of any and all rights of indemnification to which a Director or officer may be entitled whether by statute or common law.

ARTICLE VIII - DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the Corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the Corporation exclusively for the purposes of the Corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operating exclusively for charitable, educational, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501 of the Internal Revenue Code (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Circuit Court of Palm Beach County, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE IX - AMENDMENTS

Amendments to the Articles of Incorporation shall be adopted by a majority of the Board of Directors.
