A Nonprofit Corporation

Thee undersigned, acting as incorporator(s) of a corporation pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopt(s) the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

Name

The name of the corporation shall be: The Incorporated Korean-American Association of Central Florida, Inc.

ARTICLE II

Principal place of business and mailing address

ARTICLE III

Purpose(s)

The specific purpose(s) for which the corporation is organized is (are): To establish a Korean-American ethnic society open to the general public to foster an appreciation of the Korean cultural and traditional heritage through voluntary services, lectures, seminars, exhibits, traditional ceremonies and any and all other appropriate means.

This corporation is organized exclusively for one or more of the purposes as specified in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

**ARTICLES IV**  
**Manner of election of directors**

The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed is as follows: Directors shall be appointed by the president of the association who is elected at the annual meeting of the association by a plurality of the votes cast by the association members.

Any such asset not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction, in the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

No part of the net earning of this corporation shall inure to the benefits of, or be distributable to, its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that this corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in these Articles.




