ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

GADSDEN COUNTY BLACK HERITAGE, CULTURE AND EDUCATION ORGANIZATION, INCORPORATED

The undersigned subscribers of these Articles of Incorporation being natural persons and competent to contract hereby form a corporation not-for-profit under the laws of the State of Florida.

Article I Name

The name of this corporation shall be the Gadsden County Black Heritage, Culture and Education Organization, Incorporated.

Article II

Principal place of business and mailing address

The principal place of business and the mailing address of this corporation shall be 220 McArthur Street, Quincy Florida 32351.

Article III Purpose

The purpose of this corporation is to educate and develop cultural arts. historical and other significant issues and programs that may relate to the long-term community interests of minorities and other interested constituents in Gadsden County, the State of Florida and the Nation to promote and unify private and public resources and efforts to their solution.

Article IV Manner of election of directors

The subscribers to these Articles of Incorporation shall constitute the membership of this corporation for which this corporation has been established. The corporation expressly reserves the right to appoint additional subscribers to the Board of Directors not to exceed a total of nine (9) members. The corporation may appoint advisory members for the purposes of which this corporation has been established. The term of membership, additional criteria for membership, the election or appointment of membership and advisory membership, the method by which membership and advisory membership can be terminated, the voting and other rights of the members and advisory members shall be as set forth in the Bylaws.

Article V

Limitation of corporate powers

The corporate powers of this corporation are as provided in section 617.0302, Florida Statutes, unless limited as follows: No incorporator member, advisory member, or officer of this corporation shall have any vested rights prevail in, or to the assets, functions affairs or franchises of this corporation or any rights, interests or privileges which may be transferable or inheritable or which shall continue if such person's office, membership or advisory membership ceases nor shall any part of the earnings of this corporation or assets thereof inure the benefits of or be distributed to them or any of them.

Article VI

Initial registered agent and street address

The street address of the initial registered office of the corporation is Route 2, Box 393-D Quincy, Florida 32351, and the name of the Corporation's initial registered agent at that address is Anthony Powell. The registered agent hereby accepted.

Upon dissolution of this corporation the Board of Directors shall distribute all of the assets remain after payment or making provisions for the payment of all liabilities of the corporation. The corporation may distribute other remaining assets to similar organizations of the same purpose in which this corporation has been established.

Article IX Amendments

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended by the Board of Directors by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of those present at any regular meeting of special meeting of the Board provided that notice of the proposed amendment including a copy thereof have been submitted to the Board membership at least ten (10) days prior to the date of the regular or special meeting.
