AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES II & III

ARTICLE II

Principle place of business and mailing address.

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be:

ARTICLE III
PURPOSES

The specific purpose(s) for which the corporation is organized is (are):

Said corporation/organization is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to needy citizens as defined in the bylaws and to organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal Tax code).

No part of the net earnings of the corporation/organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, directors, officers or any private persons, except that the corporation/organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of Section 501(c)(3) purposes. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation/organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation/organization shall not participate in, or intervene in, (including the publishing or distribution of statements any political campaign on behalf of, of in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation/organization shall not carry on any other activities nor permitted to be carried on, (a) by a corporation/organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code) or (b) by a corporation/organization, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) or the internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code).

Upon the dissolution of this corporation/organization assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the internal Revenue Code, or government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.
