THE SCHNEER FOUNDATION, INC. PLAN OF DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS

This Plan of Distribution of Assets is made and entered into by The Schneer Foundation, Inc., a Florida not-for-profit corporation (the "Corporation"), to be effective as of December 31, 2024.

WHEREAS, it was determined by the Board of Directors of the Corporation that it would be in its best interest to dissolve as a Florida not-for-profit corporation in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida;

WHEREAS, in connection with such dissolution and in accordance with the requirements of Section 617.1406 of the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act, the Corporation desires to enter into this Plan of Distribution of Assets;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises above and intending to be legally bound hereby, the following is adopted as a Plan of Distribution of Assets for the purpose of properly distributing all assets, liabilities and obligations of the Corporation.

- All of the right, title and interest in and to all of the net assets of the Corporation shall, upon dissolution, be assigned to the Bessemer Giving Fund, for purposes of establishing a donor advised fund to be named the Schneer Bessemer Giving Fund (the "Donor Advised Fund").
- 2. Stacey L.S. Lee shall serve as the account holder of the Donor Advised Fund. Jenessa L. Freid and Jared W. Lee shall each be designated a successor account holder of the Donor Advised Fund upon the death of Stacey L.S. Lee.
- 3. The Corporation has no assets held upon a condition requiring return, transfer, or conveyance by reason of dissolution.
- 4. The officer signing below hereby certifies the Corporation's compliance with Section 617.1406(2) of the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act.
