### ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

### MOUNT CARMEL COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION

Pursuant to the provisions of section 607.1006, Florida Statutes, this Florida Non-profit corporation adopts the following articles of amendment to its articles of incorporation:

- 1. This amendment was adopted by the directors on Sunday, June 22, 1997.
- 2. All other portions of the Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation, not specifically modified or amended herein, are authorized to continue in full force and effect.

#### Article VI NON-PROFIT

This Corporation shall not carry on propaganda, or otherwise act to influence legislation or participate in political campaigns as a substantial part of its activities. No part of the income of the corporation shall be paid or inure to the benefit of any person but the corporation shall be authorized to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and may confer benefits upon its members in conformity with its purposes.

# Article VII TAX EXEMPT STATUS

Not withstanding any other provision of these Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501 (c) 3 of the Internal Revenue Code (or the corresponding provisions of any future U.S. Internal Revenue Law) or by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 (c) 2 of the Internal Revenue Code (or the corresponding provision of any future U.S. Internal Revenue Law).

## Article VIII DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS

No person, firm or corporation shall ever receive any dividends or profits from the undertakings of this corporation and upon dissolution of this organization all of its assets remaining after payment of all costs and expenses of such dissolution shall be distributed to the other organizations which have qualified for exemption under Section 501 (c) 3 of the Internal Revenue Code (or the corresponding provision of any future U.S. Internal Revenue Law), or the Federal government or to a State or local government, for a public purpose.
