

#### Amendments To Articles of Incorporation

Article III Purpose is amended by adding a new first sentence at the beginning thereof to read as follows: "The purposes for which the Miami OTAC\TAO is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, scientific, literary and educational within the meaning of 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law".

Article IV of the Articles of Incorporation is amended by inserting the words "of 1986" immediately after the word Code in line 3 of Article IV.

Paragraph 2 of Article V is amended by striking the first two sentences thereof and inserting in lieu thereof, the following new language: "In the event of dissolution of the Miami OTAC\TAO, the residual assets of the corporation will be turned over to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in sections 501 (c) (3) and 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or corresponding sections of any prior or future Internal Revenue Code, or to the Federal, State, or local government for exclusive public purpose."

Whereas, The Executive Committee of the Miami OTAC/TAO, Corp. is not a membership corporation and therefore govern by a Board of Directors and an Executive Committee

1. That the clarifications and revisions to IRS Form 1023 and any

- That the amendments to the Articles of Incorporation be filed with the 2. Florida Secretary of State and that a conformed copy of such amendments be sent to the Internal Revenue Service as soon as they become available from the Florida Secretary of State.
- That the Miami OTAC/TAO, Corp. is not a membership organization and 3. that the Executive Committee of the Board of Directors is empower to amend the Articles of Incorporation
- That a new 872-C be executed by the President of the Board. 4.
