

ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT to ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION of



ONCE DUE FIRE DEPARTMENT, INC.

Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, the undersigned Florida non-profit corporation adopts the following articles of amendment to its articles of incorporation.

FIRST: Amendment(s) adopted:

ARTICLE I is Amended to read as follows:

I. The name of the corporation is Altamonte Pass Fire Department, Inc.

ARTICLE IV is Amended to read as follows:

IV. This is a non-stock, non-profit corporation. The purpose of the corporation is to engage in any lawful act or activity for which non-profit corporations may be organized under the laws of the state of Florida.

Said corporation is organized as a volunteer fire department whose purpose shall be to provide fire protection as needed within its radii of influence: providing such other ancillary fire and life safety support activities and services including, but not limited to; fire safety education, community service projects, and the promotion of safety awareness through community programs. Included within this purpose, shall be the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law)

SECOND: The date of adoption of the amendment was March 1, 2000.

THIRD: There are no members or members entitled to vote on the amendment. The amendment was adopted by the board of directors.
