

Amendment to Article #3: This corporation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. The corporation is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for charitable and educational purposes to aid the poor and disadvantaged individuals and families towards a life of self-sufficiency. The general purpose of this corporation is to promote, promulgate, establish and disseminate the religious belief as entertained by the constitution and by-laws of said church. Activities and programs will consist of, but shall not be limited to: job training, job placement, employment, land acquisitions, community development, community redevelopment, housing, temporary shelter, counseling, teenage pregnancy, substance abuse awareness and prevention, literacy, tutoring, AIDS, elderly care, child care, performing arts, literary arts, visual arts, and other programs to aid those in need.

Add This Article:

Article #6: Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes with the meaning of section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
