IN RE: APPLICATION FOR INCORPORATION
OF A RELIGIOUS SOCIETY:

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGES OF THE ABOVE STYLED COURT:

Come now, C. L. Fain, E. M. Maddox, Robert Frierson, D. B. Maddox and Mrs. Mamie
Hose, whose residence and Post Office Addresses, is Apalachicola, Franklin County,
Florida, and do hereby associate themselves together for the purpose of forming and
creating and becoming an incorporation under and by virtue of the laws of the State
of Florida, as promulgated and enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida,
as set forth in Chapter 10095, Acts of Florida, A. D. 1925, and hereby agree and
subscribe to the following Articles of Incorporation, to-wit:

ARTICLE I.

The name of the corporation shall be THE FIRST BAPTIST CHURCH of Apalachicola,
Florida.

ARTICLE II.

The general nature and object of said Corporation shall be as follows: The study
of the word of God, through preaching, and teaching thereof in all ways and manners
in common use and practice among Missionary Baptists in the Southern Baptist Conven-
tion; To save the lost in the community and elsewhere; to train its members for more
effective and efficient services along moral and Spiritual development of its member-
ship and others; To do all things which will advance the cause and Kingdom of Christ
in the Community, and which will be in keeping with the great commission of the Lord
Jesus Christ to His people everywhere.

ARTICLE III.

The qualifications for membership shall be the same as those now in force and
effect in the Southern Baptist Convention.

ARTICLE IV.

This Corporation shall have perpetual existence, unless dissolved according to
the laws of the State of Florida.

V.

The names and residence of the subscribers, are as stated in the first paragraph
of this petition.

VI.

The business of this corporation shall be managed by a President, a Vice-President,
a Secretary, a Treasurer, and a Board of Deacons or Directors, to be chosen as set

President, Robert Frierson, Vice-President, Geo. Sizemore, Secretary and Treasurer, and D. B. Maddox, C. L. Fain, and Herman Johnson, shall compose the first Board of Directors or Deacons. The above named officers and Directors or Deacons shall serve for the first Fiscal year, beginning Oct. 1935, year of the existence of said Corporation, or until their successors shall have been elected and qualified. The officers of said corporation are to be elected on the First day of Oct. each succeeding year hereafter.

VIII.

All rules and regulations for said Corporation are to be made, altered or rescinded by a majority vote of the membership called for that purpose, and present, and voting thereat.

IX.

The highest amount of indebtedness or liabilities to which this Corporation shall at any time subject itself shall be Two-thirds of the value of the property owned by said Corporation.

X.

The amount in value of the real estate which the corporation may hold, subject to the approval of the Circuit Judge, shall be \$50,000.00.

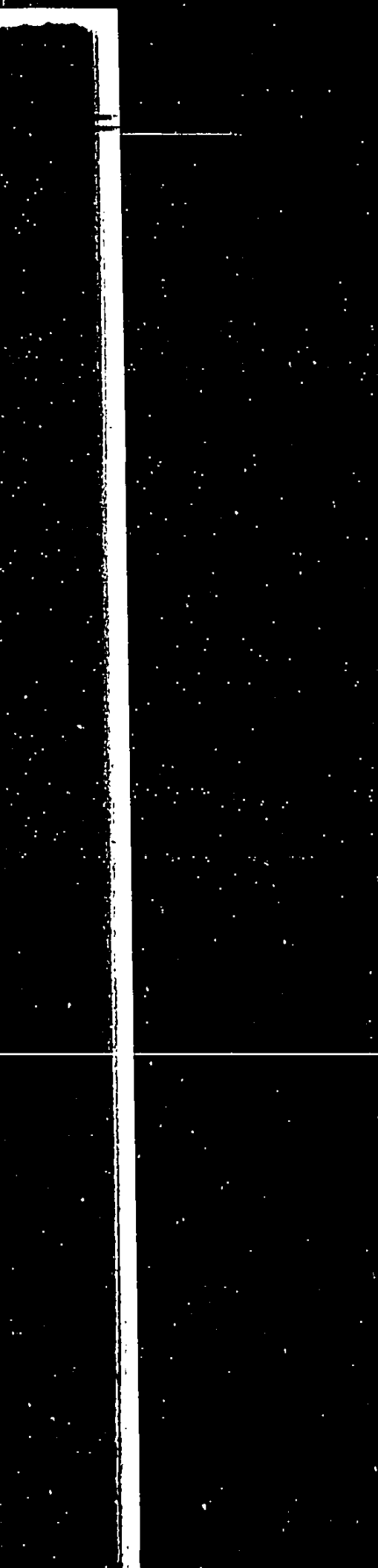

Comes now THE FIRST BAPTIST CHURCH OF APALACHICOLA, FLORIDA, a religious corporation, of Apalachicola, Franklin County, Florida, and says:

1.

That it was incorporated March 31st., A.D. 1936, by Order of the Honorable

That the present facilities of the First Baptist Church, of Apalachicola, Florida, are inadequate for the religious education of its members and their children, as well as others that desire to attend such religious Sunday-School and other similar functions, and it has become necessary to construct a new Educational building at a cost of approximately \$25,000.00. That to do so it will be necessary to amend Article X of its Articles of Incorporation, and for that reason, under and by authority of Chapter 617 Florida Statutes of 1953, it requests this Honorable Court that it be granted the relief as set forth in its Resolution, to-wit: -

A RESOLUTION BY THE FIRST BAPTIST CHURCH, OF APALACHICOLA, FLORIDA, AMENDING ARTICLE X OF ITS ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION AS INCORPORATED BY ORDER OF THE CIRCUIT COURT IN AND FOR FRANKLIN COUNTY, FLORIDA, DATED 31st DAY OF MARCH, 1936, BY INCREASING FROM \$50,000.00 TO \$150,000.00 THE AMOUNT IN VALUE OF REAL ESTATE WHICH THE CORPORATION MAY HOLD; AND FOR THE COURT TO APPROVE THE REAL ESTATE OWNED BY THE CORPORATION; AND AUTHORIZING THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW EDUCATIONAL BUILDING ON ITS REAL ESTATE AT A COST OF SOME \$25,000.00.

WHEREAS, The First Baptist Church of Apalachicola, Florida, was duly incorporated by Order of the Honorable E. C. Love, Circuit Judge, dated 31st day of March A.D. 1936, and

WHEREAS, Article X of the Articles of Incorporation reads as follows: "The amount in value of the real estate which the corporation may hold, subject to the approval of the Circuit Judge, shall be \$50,000.00.", and

WHEREAS, the value of real estate has increased very much since the year 1936, and also additional real estate has been procured since that time, and

WHEREAS, the real estate now owned by the First Baptist Church of Apalachicola, Florida, is as follows, to-wit:-

All of Lots Number 2,3,4, and 5 in Block 39 of the City of Apalachicola, Franklin County, Florida, according to the map or plat of said City in general use,

and

WHEREAS, The First Baptist Church of Apalachicola, Florida, is now constructing on its real estate, an Educational Building for church purposes, at a cost of some \$25,000.00, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that Article X of its Charter be amended to increase the amount of real estate it may hold from \$50,000.00 to the amount of \$150,000.00, because when said Educational Building is completed the value of its real estate will be considerable more than the \$50,000.00 allowed under its present Articles of Incorporation, and

WHEREAS, The First Baptist Church of Apalachicola, Florida, is in need of said Educational Building, for the religious education of its members and their children, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FIRST BAPTIST CHURCH OF APALACHICOLA, FLORIDA:

1st. That Article X of the Articles of Incorporation dated the 31st day of March, A. D. 1936, and recorded in Corporation Record Book "B", on pages 51-53, of the Public Records of Franklin County, Florida be amended by the Circuit Court to read as follows, to-wit:-

The amount in value of the real estate which the corporation may hold, shall be \$150,000.00

2nd. The ownership by The First Baptist Church of Apalachicola, Florida, of the following real estate in Franklin County, Florida, be authorized and approved by the Circuit Court, to-wit:-

All of Lots Number 2,3,4, and 5 in Block 39, of the City of Apalachicola, Franklin County, Florida, according to the map or plat of said City in general use.

3rd. That the Circuit Court do authorize the construction on the above described property of a new Educational Building at a cost of approximately \$25,000.00.

4th. Adopted at a regular meeting of the members of The First Baptist Church, of Apalachicola, Florida, held in the auditorium of said church, in the City of Apalachicola, Florida, in accordance with its charter and by-laws, on this the 9th. day of March, 1955.

FRANKLIN COUNTY SPORTSMENS
ASSOCIATION

CHARTER

Article 1

The name of this organization shall be Franklin County Sportsmen's Association and shall be a corporation not for profit and shall be located in Franklin County, Florida

Article 11

The objects of this organization are to bring together men and women who are hunters, fishermen or lovers of the great outdoors, to promote good sportsmanship and fellowship among its members, to preserve our forests and to protect and conserve wild animals, birds and fish, so that our own and future generations may continue to enjoy the advantages, benefits and pleasures of hunting and fishing and outdoor life in general.

Article III

Any white man or woman shall be eligible for active membership who is over 16 years of age, who subscribes in sincerity to the ethics of good sportsmanship and who is a true lover of the great outdoors, and who satisfies the Board of Directors that he or she is in hearty accord with the spirit and purposes of this organization.

Article IV

The general management and control of the affairs and property of the organization shall be vested in a Board of Directors of nine persons who shall be resident members of the county and shall serve as follows: The President who shall be elected each year; for the first year, four directors for one year; four directors for two years, and four directors for two years each year thereafter. Such directors to be from Franklin County as a whole and to be elected fro the time provided at a regular annual meeting of this association. These directors shall serve until their successors shall have been elected by ballot and shall have qualified.

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
