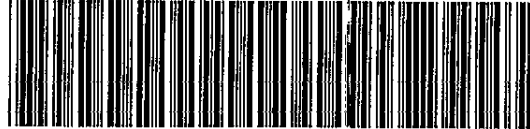


Dear Anna:



ARTICLE III. GENERAL AND SPECIFIC PURPOSES

SAFETY SYSTEMS INTERNATIONAL TRAINING INSTITUTE, INC. is organized for educational (safety and emergency management), charitable and faith-based (mentoring and tutoring) purposes pursuant to the Florida Corporations Not For Profit law set forth in Part 1 of Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes.

- A. The corporation is authorized to make and perform contracts of any kind and description for the purpose of attaining any of the objectives of the corporation; to do and perform any other act or thing; to exercise any and all powers which a copartnership or a natural person could do and exercise and which are now or hereafter may be authorized by law, and generally to do and perform any and all things necessary or incident to the performing and carrying out of the powers hereinabove specifically delegated or implied.
- B. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles of Incorporation to operate exclusively for such charitable, educational, and/or religious/faith-based purposes as will qualify it as an exempt organization under Section 501©(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations which qualify as tax-exempt organizations under that Code. This corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by any organization exempt from federal income tax under the above-described statute.
- C. This corporation shall not, as a substantial part of its activities, carry on propaganda or otherwise attempt to influence legislation; nor shall it participate or intervene (by publication or distribution of any statements or otherwise) in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.
- D. In the event of dissolution, the residual assets of the organization will be turned over to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in Section 501©(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or corresponding sections of any prior or future Internal Revenue Code, or to the federal, state or local government for exclusive public purpose.
- E. This corporation shall not discriminate against any member, director, employee, contractor or any other person associated with it in any manner because of race, color, religion, sex, national origin, political choice and/or any other diversity. The corporation will take affirmative action to ensure that all individuals are treated with respect during association with the corporation without regard to their diversity.
