## ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

## artek media inc.

ON FEB 16 MIII.5 Pursuant to the provisions of section 607.1006. Florida Statues, this Florida nonprofit corporation adopts the following articles of amendment to its articles of incorporation:

Amendment adopted:

ARTICLE III PURPOSE(S) (amended)

Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, educational religious or scientific purposes, within the meaning of section 501c(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Amendment adopted: II.

ARTICLE VII (added)

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered to and make payments and distributions in furtherance of section 501c(3) purposes. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

ARTICLE VIII (added)

Not Withstanding any other provision of these article, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under section 501c(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code).

Amendment adopted: IV.

ARTICLE IX (added)

Upon dissolution of this corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501c(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code), i.e. charitable, educational, religious or scientific, or shall be distributed to the Federal government, or to a Sate or local government for a public purpose.
