The following statements in Article III: Purpose and the Article X: Dissolution was added to the Articles of Incorporation for Christian Faith Church Inc.:

#### ARTICLE III: PURPOSE

- (a) The purposes for which the organization is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, scientific, literary, and educational within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.
- (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal Income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

### ARTICLE X: DISSOLUTION

In the event of dissolution, the residual assets of the organization will be turn over to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations describe in sections 501(c)(3) and 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or corresponding sections of any prior or future Internal Revenue Code, or to the Federal, State, or local government for exclusive public purpose.
