



ADOPTED AMENDMENTS TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION LONG BAYOU ROAD ASSOCIATION, INC.

1. Adopted amendment to Articles of Incorporation, Article 5., as follows:

ARTICLE 5: MEMBERSHIP

The names and addresses of the members of the Corporation are as follows:

LONG BAYOU CONDOMINIUM II ASSOCIATION, INC. THE PALMS OF LONG BAYOU, INC.

2. Adopted amendment to Articles of Incorporation, Article 6., as follows:

ARTICLE 6: DIRECTORS
