ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

ARTICLE III

The purposes for which this corporation is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, scientific, literary and educational within the meaning of Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted by an organization exempt from Federal Income tax under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

In the even of dissolution, the residual assets of the organization will be turned over to one or more organizations which, themselves, are exempt as organizations described in Section 501 (c)(3). Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction, in the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes.
