# ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

PEN HAVEN NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH ASSOCIATION, INC. a Florida nonprofit corporation



### ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation is Pen Haven Neighborhood Watch Association, Inc., a Florida nonprofit corporation.

### ARTICLE II - DURATION

The term of existence of the corporation is perpetual.

### ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

The corporation is organized to provide assistance to local law enforcement agencies, maintain a clean, healthy and safe environment for all residents of the Pen Haven Neighborhood and to facilitate participation by residents in exchanging ideas for the peaceful enjoyment of the community. All activities of the corporation shall be exclusively for charitable, educational and scientific purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

# ARTICLE IV - ADDRESS

The address of the initial principal office of the corporation is 1414 North 48th Avenue, Pensacola, Florida 32506. The mailing address is the same.

# ARTICLE V - DIRECTORS AND OFFICERS

There shall be five members of the initial Board of Directors

of the corporation. The names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as Directors and the offices they shall hold until the first election thereof are as follows:

# ARTICLE VI - INCORPORATOR

The incorporator of this Florida nonprofit corporation is H. G. Frederick, 1414 North 48th Avenue, Pensacola, Florida 32506.

### ARTICLE VII - MEMBERS

The corporation shall have a membership distinct from the Board of Directors. The number and qualifications of the members of the corporation, the manner of their admission, the different classes of membership, if any, other rights and privileges of members, and their liability for dues and assessments and the method of collection thereof, shall be set forth in the by-laws.

#### ARTICLE VIII - BY-LAWS

The By-laws of the corporation are to be made, altered, or rescinded by the Directors of the corporation.

# ARTICLE IX - AMENDMENTS TO ARTICLES

These articles of incorporation may be amended by the act of the Directors of the corporation. Such amendments may be proposed and adopted in the manner provided in the By-laws of the corporation.

# ARTICLE X - REGISTERED AGENT

The initial registered agent of the corporation shall be: H. G. Frederick, 1414 North 48th Avenue, Pensacola, FL 32506

# ARTICLE XI - DEDICATION OF ASSETS

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer, or member thereof, or the benefit of any private individual.

## ARTICLE XII - DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS

Upon the dissolution of this corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of the corporation, shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation, or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue

Code of 1954, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws.


