ARTICLE II


The Corporation filed articles of incorporation with the Florida Department of State on November 14, 1997, effective November 10, 1997.

PLAN OF DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS

Pursuant to Section 617.1406, Florida Statutes, American Community Foundation, Inc. Files the following plan of distribution of assets in connection with the dissolution of the Corporation:

1. All debts, obligations and liabilities of the Corporation have been paid or discharged.
2. No assets are held by the Corporation requiring return, transfer, or conveyances by reason of the dissolution.
3. No assets are held by the Corporation subject to limitations permitting their use only for charitable or similar purposes.
4. Pursuant to the Articles of Incorporation, any assets remaining after the payment of all debts, obligations, and liabilities of the Corporation shall be distributed to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt organizations described in Sections 501(c)(3) and 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding sections of any prior or future law, or to the Federal government for exclusively public purposes.
5. The Corporation has no members and adopted this Plan of Distribution by written consent of all three members of the Board of Directors of the Corporation on MARCH 31, 2000.
