ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

FOCUS ON ISRAEL INTERNATIONAL, INC. A NON-PROFIT CORPORATION

The undersigned, acting as incorporators of a corporation under the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act, hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be Focus On Israel International, Inc.

ARTICLE 11

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be 2797 S.W. 14th Court, Deerfield Beach FL 33442-6020.

ARTICLE III

The corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, educational and religious purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Sections 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law). The MAIN PURPOSE is to foster a love of Jewish People through educating both Jews and Gentiles as to

their common roots. As Christians, we would honor our Jewish Lord and the Gospel and stand in solidarity with the Jewish people and Nation of Israel. We stand against anti-Semitism in every form, subtle or blatant, whether within the Church or without, in any religious or non-religious group.

These purposes encompasses the presentation of concerts, published books and articles, radio programs, television programs, audio recordings, video recordings, meetings, tours, special projects and the Internet.

ARTICLE IV

The business affairs of this corporation shall be managed by the Board of Directors. The number of initial directors of this corporation is five. The number of directors may be increased from time to time, by the by-laws, but shall never be less than three. The Board of Directors shall be members of the corporation and shall be elected and hold office in accordance with the by-laws.

The corporate powers of this corporation are as provided in section 617.0302, Florida Statutes, unless limited are as follows:

This corporation may do and perform all such acts and things, including those generally allowed by the laws of FLORIDA relative to corporations not for profit, as now existing, or as the law may henceforth provide, as from time to time may be necessary or expedient to the exercise of any and all of its corporate functions, powers and rights.

ARTICLE VIII

Any additional provisions for the operation of the corporation are as follows:

Upon the dissolution of this corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.

No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation (except as otherwise provided by Section 501 (h) of the Internal Revenue Code), and this corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

No part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that this corporation shall be authorized to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in these Articles.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (1) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code or (2) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code.

In any taxable year in which this corporation is a private foundation as described in Section 509 (a) of the Internal Revenue Code, the corporation 1) shall distribute its income for said period at such time and manner as not to subject it to tax under Section 4942 of the Internal Revenue Code; 2) shall not engage in any act of self-dealing as defined in Section 4941 (d) of the Internal Revenue Code; 3) shall not retain any excess business holdings as defined in Section 4943 (c) of the Internal Revenue Code; 4) shall not make any investments in such manner as to subject the corporation to tax under Section 4944 of the Internal Revenue Code; and 5) shall not make any taxable expenditures as defined in Section 4945 (d) of the Internal Revenue Code.
