AGREEMENT FOR MERGER BETWEEN

GREATER WEST VOLUSIA CHAMBER OF COMMERCE AND GREATER ORANGE CITY AREA CHAMBER OF COMMERCE

THIS AGREEMENT is made this <u>30</u> day of <u>Jame</u>, 2001, by and between the Greater Orange City Area Chamber of Commerce, Inc. (Hereinafter referred to as Orange City Chamber), and the Greater West Volusia Chamber of Commerce, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as Greater West Volusia Chamber).

Whereas both the Orange City Chamber and the Greater West Volusia Chamber endeavor to better serve the businesses and communities of West Volusia County, and to do so with greater efficiency and effectiveness; and

Whereas both chambers have voted to combine into one continuing Chamber of Commerce known as the Chamber of Commerce of West Volusia.

It is hereby agreed that in order to effectuate the merger into one combined entity the following procedural steps will be taken as soon as possible; but no later than by July 10, 2001:

- 1. The Board of Directors of Orange City Chamber shall consider and recommend to the Greater West Volusia Chamber whether to Amend Articles of Merger or register the name of "Chamber of Commerce of West Volusia" with the Florida Department of State to implement the new name for the continuing corporation.
- 2. The Board of Directors of Greater West Volusia Chamber shall vote at a special meeting to adopt the new By-Laws previously approved by both Chambers prior to the end of June, 2001, and shall adopt the name change to "Chamber of Commerce of West

Volusia".

3. The Board of Directors of Greater West Volusia Chamber shall vote to amend the new By-Laws for the interim period (through December 31, 2001) to combine the officers and boards of directors of both chambers into one continuing entity. There shall be a sharing of officer's duties and one resulting board of directors during this period. The temporary by-law changes will expire December 31, 2001.

- 4. The new combined board of directors shall, no later than the first monthly meeting in July, 2001, ratify and approve the transfer of all members of the Orange City Chamber to the Chamber of Commerce of West Volusia, and shall ratify and approve the transfer of the remaining assets (personal property and bank accounts) of the Orange City Chamber to the Chamber of Commerce of West Volusia.
- 5. The executive committee of the Orange City Chamber shall ensure that a bill of sale for the corporation's personal property is signed, and that the corporate accounts are transferred to those of the "Chamber of Commerce of West Volusia".
- 6. The implementation of the merger of the Orange City Chamber and Greater
 West Volusia Chamber are contingent upon the above described procedures taking place.
