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# ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT

Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, the undersigned Florida nonprofit corporation adopts the following articles of amendment to its articles of incorporation.

FIRST: Article 3, shall be deleted in its entirety and the following shall be in its place and stead.

# Article 3. Purposes. The purpose of the Corporation is as follows:

- A. This Corporation is a not-for-profit Corporation organized under Chapter 617, Florida Statutes. It is not organized for the private gain of any person. Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of contributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- B. To limit all rights and powers to those within the section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- C. To exercise all rights and powers conferred by the laws of the State of Florida upon nonprofit corporations except where not in conflict with section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- D. All corporate assets will be used solely for the exempt purpose of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- E. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.
- F. Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal, state, or local government for a public purpose. any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes.
