Articles of Incorporation of Retirees of Richmond Heights, Incorporated.

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The undersigned persons, acting as incorporators of a corporation not for profit under the Florida Not For Profit Corporations Act, as set forth in Chapter 617 of the Florida Statues, adopt the following articles of incorporation for the corporation.

Article I

The name of the corporation is the Retirees of Richmond Heights Incorporated.

Article II

The corporation shall have perpetual duration.

Article III

The Retirees of Richmond Heights, Incorporated is organized exclusively for charitable, educational or scientific purposes, within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code.

No part of the net earning of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to its members, trustees, directors, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to make reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of Section 501(c)(3) purposes. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future federal tax code) or (b) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code.)

Upon dissolution of this corporation assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, i.e. charitable, educational, religious or scientific, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal government or to a state or local government for a public purpose.

ARTICLE IV
