The undersigned, acting as incorporator(s) of a corporation pursuant to chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopt(s) the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE | NAME

This corporation is organized and shall operate exclusively for religious, charitable, educational, literary, and scientific purposes but limited to exempt purposes described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law); and this Corporation may engage in only such activities permitted under the laws of the State of Florida and the United States of America as shall constitute furtherance of such exempt purposes. In furtherance of such exempt purposes, it may promote, establish, conduct and maintain activities on its own behalf and it may contribute to or otherwise assist other corporations, organizations and institutions that qualify as exempt organizations under said Section 501(c)(3).

In the event of the partial or complete liquidation or the dissolution of the corporation, the residual assets of the corporation will be turned over to (a) one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as described in Section 501(c)(3) and Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or corresponding sections of any prior or future Internal Revenue Code, or (b) to any Federal, State or local government for public purpose. Any assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the Principal office of the corporation in then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
