ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a not for profit corporation under Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, does hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I: NAME

The name of the corporation is **Montessori Teacher Education Center/Pensacola, Inc.**

ARTICLE II: PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal place of business and mailing address of the corporation is 20 Jamison Street, Pensacola, Florida 32507.

ARTICLE III: PURPOSE

To provide educational experiences for the student in order to teach in a Montessori Early Childhood Classroom with children ages 3-6.

ARTICLE IV: QUALIFICATION

The qualifications for members and the manner of their admission are stated in the bylaws of the corporation.

ARTICLE V: INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

ARTICLE X: AMENDMENTS

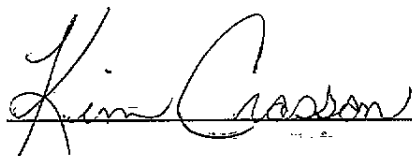
The corporation reserves the right to amend or repeal any provisions of these Articles of Incorporation, or any amendment(s) thereto.
