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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION AND CHARTER

OF

CRESTWELL HIGHER LEARNING PRIVATE SCHOOL, INC.

We, the undersigned, with other persons being desirous of forming a corporation not for profit, under the provisions of Chapter 617 and Chapter 623 of the Florida Statutes, do agree to the following:

ARTICLE I. NAME AND ADDRESS

The name of this corporation is CRESTWELL HIGHER LEARNING PRIVATE SCHOOL, INC. The principal business address of the corporation is \$140 College Parkway, Fort Myers, Florida 33919.

ARTICLE II. GEOGRAPHIC OPERATIONS

The geographic area in which this private school shall operate will be in Lee County, Florida.

ARTICLE III. PURPOSES

The general nature of the objects and purposes of this corporation shall be:

1. The purpose of this organization shall be to provide a unique and stimulating educational environment for those qualified children between the ages of 10 and 18 years through the operation, ownership, and control of Crestwell Higher Learning Private School

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- 2. The purposes for which the corporation is organized are exclusively charitable, scientific, literary and educational within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the correspondence provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.
- 3. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

The Directors will determine the recipients of the assets and monies.

ARTICLE XII. LOCATION

The location of this corporation shall initially be at 8140 College Parkway, in the City of Fort Myers, County of Lee, State of Florida. The Board of Directors may designate such other and additional addresses for the location of the corporation as it may from time to time see fit.
