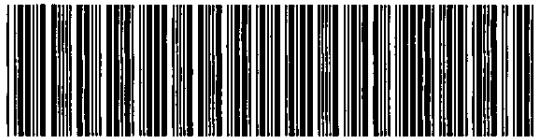

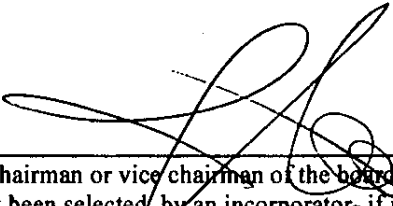

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

(Amended 09/09/2008)

The undersigned incorporators, natural persons 18 years of age or older, in order to form a corporate entity under Florida Statutes, Chapter 617, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I

Name

The name of this corporation shall be:

Auburndale Youth Basketball League, Inc.

ARTICLE II

Principal place of business and mailing address

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be:

ARTICLE III

Purposes

The specific purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

This corporation is organized exclusively for, and will be operated exclusively for, charitable and educational purposes, within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, and to provide recreational activities for boys and girls interested in athletics, with emphasis upon fun and enjoyment of sports, good sportsmanship, and fair play, and to serve to introduce youngsters to the basic fundamentals of basketball, and to provide adequate instruction as these youngsters advance in their skills.

ARTICLE IV

Manner of election of directors

The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed is as follows:

The method of election of directors shall be as stated in the bylaws.

ARTICLE V
Limitation of corporate powers

The corporate powers of this corporation are as provided in section 617.0302, Florida Statutes, unless limited are as follows:

The corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code; nor shall the corporation engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation.

ARTICLE VI

ARTICLE VII
Debt Obligations and Personal Liability

No member, officer or Director of this corporation shall be personally liable for the debts or obligations of this corporation of any nature whatsoever, nor shall any of the property of the members, officers or Directors be subject to the payment of the debts or obligations of this corporation.

ARTICLE VIII
Dissolution

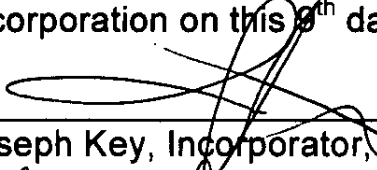
Upon the time of dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed by the Board of Directors, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all debts, obligations, liabilities, costs and expenses of the corporation, for one or more exempt purposes with in the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
