ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO THE ARTICLE OF INCORPORATION FOR WE CHANGE FOUNDATION INC.

Pursuant to the provisions of Florida Non-Profit Corporation Act, the undersigned corporation adopts the following Article of Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation which: The corporation has no members. The following amendments to the Articles of Incorporation was adopted by the corporation board of directors on March 24, 1998, at 568 East Woolbright, Road, Boynton Beach, Florida 33435. The Articles of Incorporation, are hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Said organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

No part of the net earnings of the organization shall insure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not participate in, or intervenue in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on(a) by an organization exempt form federal income tax under section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions not which federal tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes withing the meaning of section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, Which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
