ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
TARPON SPRINGS HIGH FOOTBALL BOOSTERS, INC.

A FLORIDA NONPROFIT CORPORATION

ARTICLE ONE

The name of the corporation not for profit is TARPON SPRINGS HIGH FOOTBALL BOOSTERS, INC.

ARTICLE TWO

This is a nonprofit corporation organized solely for general educational purposes, specifically to promote, enhance, support and assist the FOOTBALL PROGRAM at Tarpon Springs High School by the distribution of its funds for such purposes.

ARTICLE THREE

The general purposes for which this corporation is formed are to operate exclusively for such educational purposes as will qualify it as an exempt organization under the provisions of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws.

This corporation shall not, as a substantial part of its activities, carry on propaganda or otherwise attempt to influence legislation; nor shall it participate or intervene (by publication or distribution of any statements or otherwise) in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

ARTICLE FOUR

This corporation shall have a perpetual existence.

ARTICLE FIVE

The corporation shall have a membership distinct from the board of directors. The authorized number and qualifications of the members of the corporation, the manner of their admission, the different classes of membership, if any, the property, voting and other rights and privileges of members and their liability for dues and assessments and the methods of collections thereof shall be set forth in the bylaws.

ARTICLE SIX

The name and address of each incorporator is:

ARTICLE SEVEN

The affairs of this corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors composed of no less than three (3) members of this corporation. The authorized number and qualifications of members of the Board of Directors, the manner of their election or appointment, their tenure and the filling of vacancies shall be stated in the bylaws.

ARTICLE EIGHT

(a) The county in the State of Florida of the initial principal office for the transaction of the business of this corporation is to be located in the County of Pinellas.

(b) The street address of the initial principal office is ~~1411~~ Gulf Road, South, Tarpon Springs, Florida 34689.

(c) The street address of the corporation's initial registered office and the name of its initial registered agent at that address is: 1411 Gulf Road, So., Tarpon Springs, Florida 34689; DON DAVIS.

ARTICLE NINE

ARTICLE TEN

Subject to the limitations contained in the bylaws, and any limitations set forth in the Corporations Not for Profit law of Florida, concerning corporate action that must be authorized or approved by the members of the corporation, bylaws of this corporation may be made, altered, rescinded, added to, or new bylaws may be adopted, either by a resolution of the Board of Directors or by following the procedure set forth therefor in the bylaws.

ARTICLE ELEVEN

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to educational purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer, or member thereof, or to the benefit of any private individual.

ARTICLE TWELVE

Upon the dissolution or winding up of this corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of the corporation, shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for educational purposes and which has established its exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws.

ARTICLE THIRTEEN

Amendments to these articles of incorporation may be proposed by a resolution adopted by the Board of Directors and presented to a quorum of members for their vote.

Amendments may be adopted by the vote of a majority of members of the corporation.

We, the undersigned, being the incorporators of this corporation, and including all the persons named as the subscribers of this corporation, for the purpose of forming this nonprofit educational corporation under the Laws of the State of Florida have executed these articles of incorporation on the 19 day of December, 1997.
