ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

GLADES EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION, INC.

a Florida corporation not-for-profit

The undersigned, acting as incorporators of a not-for-profit corporation pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopt the following articles of incorporation:

ARTICLE I. CORPORATE NAME AND DURATION. The name of this corporation (otherwise known as "Foundation") shall be GLADES EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION, INC. The existence of this corporation shall begin on the date the certificate of incorporation is issued by the Secretary of State for the State of Florida and shall continue perpetually thereafter unless dissolved as provided by law. The corporation address is P.O. Box 459, Avenue L & 10th Street, Moore Haven, FL 33471.

ARTICLE II. OBJECT AND PURPOSE. The object and purpose of the Foundation shall be to provide charitable, scientific and educational aid in the form of money, and other forms of property and services to the School Board of Glades County, Florida (hereinafter referred to as the "School Board"), its successors and assigns, and to persons, associations and corporations associated therewith; to promote education and other related activities of the Board; to encourage research, learning and dissemination of information in which the Board is carrying on activities within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

The Foundation is created to be a district school board direct-support organization pursuant to Florida Statute 237.40; and

also is governed by Rule 6A-1.0013, Florida Administrative Code (i.e., F.A.C.) and any other state statute, State Board of Education rule or applicable federal law, now or hereafter in effect.

ARTICLE III. POWERS. The Foundation shall have the power and authority:

- 1. To solicit, receive, and hold by gift, bequest, devise, grant, and to acquire by purchase, lease, exchange or otherwise, property, both real and personal, either as absolute owner or as trustee thereof, and to manage and administer the same.
- 2. To act and perform the duties of trustees or to act in any other fiduciary capacity under any deed or trust, will, codicil, agreement, whether oral or written, or other instrument incidental to and for the purpose of carrying out any lawful purpose of the foundation and to obligate itself to perform and execute any and all such conditions or trusts.
- 3. To make and receive contributions, grants, gifts and transfers of property, both real and personal, either outright or in trust, to or for the benefit of the School Board, or to or for the benefit of other organizations identified, associated with and approved by the Board which are tax exempt organizations under the provisions of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of the United States of America, or acts amendatory thereof or supplementary thereto.
- 4. In general to do and perform all things necessary and to have all powers necessary and provided to non-profit corporations under Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, needful or desirable to encourage, promote and provide with funds obtained, opportunities for the School Board to serve the needs of citizens residing primarily in Glades County. The Board of Directors of the Foundation shall have full power to modify the conditions and regulations under which any funds received shall be spent, so as to secure the application of the funds in the best manner adapted to the conditions of the time and to the needs of the School Board;

provided, however, that the transactions of the Foundation shall at all times be related to the general purposes included in previous sections.

ARTICLE IV. ACTIVITIES NOT PERMITTED. This Foundation shall not:

- 1. Declare or pay any dividend.
- 2. Pay, give or loan to or for the benefit of any director or other private individual (except as (a) reimbursement for Foundation expenses incurred for the Foundation's lawful benefit, or (b) as reasonable compensation for lawful services rendered to the Foundation or for property or thing of value acquired by the Foundation for valid Foundation purposes) any money or Foundation asset.
- 3. Notwithstanding anything herein to the contrary, the Foundation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 ("the code") or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Revenue law.
- 4. Participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.
- 5. No substantial part of the activities of this Foundation shall be for carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, except for the proper benefit of the School Board and the purposes permitted for this direct support organization under state and federal law.
- 6. Any activities which would be improper as a recipient of tax-deductible contributions under Section 170(c)(2) of the Code.

ARTICLE V. MEETINGS, PLACES HELD AND NOTICE. Meetings of the Foundation shall be held not less often than quarterly (i.e., at least four each fiscal year) and will usually be held in the School Board's meeting room or in the Glades County Commission's meeting

room or in the Moore Haven City Commission's meeting room. However, Foundation meetings may, from time to time, be held in other public places, both within and without Glades County and the State of Florida. Regardless of where held, public notice thereof shall be given not less than three days (i.e., 72 hours) in advance by public service announcement in the <u>Glades County Democrat</u>. A so-called "legal" ad or notice shall not be necessary if a public service announcement is not given by the newspaper.

ARTICLE VI. MEMBERS.

- 1. The membership of the Foundation shall be not less than five (5) nor more than thirty (30) persons; and the original incorporators shall be the first members.
- 2. The original incorporators, with the advice and consent of the School Board, shall select the initial membership.
- 3. Vacancies caused by deaths, resignations or other causes shall be filled by vote of the membership subject to ratification by the School Board.
- 4. Membership shall not be limited to persons residing in Glades County. Indeed, in order to better promote and accomplish the object and purpose of the Foundation, it is expected that some persons who reside outside Glades County will be sought as members.
 - 5. Directors are elected in accordance with the By-laws.

ARTICLE VII. INCORPORATORS; INITIAL OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS.

The initial registered agent for the Foundation shall be GARY L. CLARK, whose work address is in that same office and whose physical residence address is Rodeo Drive, Moore Haven, FL 33471.
